Product Condition:

- Removal and or Defacing of Serial/Part number sticker(s) on ANY Diamond Multimedia products WILL void ALL warranties.
- All products must be returned in the originally sold condition. Products received by Diamond Multimedia for replacement that include 3rd-party attachments will be returned to the address on the package.

- All products must return in their original packaging with all original components.
- There must be no physical damage to any component including damage that is caused by:
 - inadequate or improper repairs carried out by any person or entity which is not authorized by the manufacturer to perform warranty services on its behalf; negligence, accidents, modifications, defective installation or misuse and use of inappropriate spare parts;
 - fire, immersion in liquid, lightning, earthquake, inadequate ventilation, Acts of God, incorrect application of main voltage howsoever arising, or any other cause beyond the control of Diamond Multimedia;
 - any other goods which can be used with the product, but are not the product itself;
 - consumable or wearing items requiring replacement as part of normal service, including (but not limited to) dry cells and rechargeable batteries.

Replacement of Product:
